

De Wildenberg



De Wildenberg is a recently restored historical thatched farmhouse in the valley of the river Reest (in the south of the province of Drenthe). It is beautifully situated, bordered by woods, heath and meadows, in the centre of nature reserve "De Wildenberg"

The neighbours are the roe deer, the badgers, the storks and the frogs in the nearby "Spookmeer" (Ghost Lake). It is a place to come to rest. Where it is still pitch dark at night and where you can see a bright starry sky as if you are in the south of France. Where the silence is almost audible.

Recently, a part of the farmhouse has become available as a holiday-home for a maximum of 6 persons

It is the ideal starting point for bird watchers, star watchers and other nature lovers, walkers or cyclists.

Your accommodation



The holiday-home consists of:

-de Deel (the former attached barn) A spacious living-room (70m²) with a bar and open kitchen, dining-table, sitting area with TV, a wooden staircase to the second floor with a balcony with a games table and an extra bed in the old "farm hand room". All this with a beautiful view on the surroundings through the large windows in the former barn doors.

-Two spacious bedrooms for two (each 20m²), one of which is fitted out with a double bed.

-Toilet and shower

-In the orchard we have created a picnic area for you. From your deckchair you can enjoy the view of the Reest valley.

You will hear the tapping of the great spotted woodpecker behind you, above you the honey buzzard is circling to find its prey, and within a hundred metres you will see the roe deer grazing in the meadows.

Prices

As a guest of De Wildenberg, not only do you have a very spacious accommodation at your disposal but also a large garden with a lovely sitting area in the orchard with a view of the setting sun in the evening. Besides, you can just step out of the garden into the woods or the meadows or you can take a path of a few hundred metres leading to the heath.

Living in the centre of nature reservation De Wildenberg is valuable and delightful, but yet not expensive. We have opened up part of our farmhouse because this place is too beautiful to only keep to ourselves.

Smoking is not allowed in the farm and unfortunately you will have to leave your pet at home, in order to prevent conflicts with our dog.

The possibilities

You rent the entire accommodation for:

- a weekend (Friday 16.00 to Monday 10.00)
- a mid-week (Monday 16.00 to Friday 10.00)
- one or more weeks (Friday or Monday 16.00 to Friday or Monday 10.00)
 - The basic group is 4 persons maximum. For each additional person (2 max) we will charge € 10 per night
 - If desired, we will serve you an extensive farmer's breakfast for an additional € 12,50 per person a day.
 - We have two rates: the high season (May up to and including September + school holidays) and the low season (October-April, school holidays excluded)
 - School holidays in 2008
 - Spring break: 15 February – 3 March
 - Easter weekend: 21-24 March
 - May break: 25 April – 6 May
 - Autumn break: 10 – 27 October
 - Christmas break: 19 December – 5 January (2009)
 - High season: 1 week € 520
 - High season: 1 weekend or mid-week € 310
 - Low season: 1 week € 355
 - Low season: 1 weekend or mid-week € 230

Where can I find De Wildenberg?

From the north

Take the N48 direction Ommen / turn right at exit Linde / after 20 metres turn left / after 400 metres left at the roundabout: Ommerweg / Follow this road for 4 kilometres / turn right at bus stop (sign direction Wildenberg) / Follow the Nieuwe Dijk for 2 kilometres / turn left at sand track (sign Wildenberg) / after 600 metres: De Wildenberg

From the south

Take the N48 from Ommen direction Hoogeveen / exit Balkbrug: in Balkbrug turn right at traffic lights / turn right after 20 metres: Hoogeveenseweg / follow this road for 2 kilometres / turn right at bus stop (sign direction Wildenberg) / Follow the Nieuwe Dijk for 2 kilometres / turn left at sand track (sign Wildenberg) / after 600 metres: De Wildenberg

From the west

Take the A28 from Zwolle direction Meppel / Exit Nieuwleusen (near former water tower) / through Nieuwleusen to Balkbrug / in Balkbrug turn left at traffic lights / turn right after 20 metres: Hoogeveenseweg / follow this road for 2 kilometres / turn right at bus stop (sign direction Wildenberg) / Follow the Nieuwe Dijk for 2 kilometres / turn left at sand track (sign Wildenberg) / after 600 metres: De Wildenberg
